# Salaat-ul-Ayaat (Salaat of the Signs)

This prayer becomes obligatory (*Wajib*) when natural phenomena (acts of Allah) take place such as earthquakes, Solar and Lunar eclipses, major hurricanes, tornados and cyclones.

## Obligatory components of this Salaat are:

- 1. Intention. It is obligatory (Wajib)
- 2. Two Rakaat
- 3. Each Rakaat has five (5) *Qiyaam* (standing up and reciting Surah Al-Fatihah and another short Surah) and five (5) Ruku.
- 4. After the fifth Ruku stand up and go to Sajdah
- 5. Repeat the same sequence in the second Rakaat
- 6. Rests of the components are like the regular Salaat (Tashahhud, salaam, etc.)

Optional: Qunoot is optional. There are total of five Qunoot in the Salaat. Two Qunoot in first Rakaat

(In 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> *Qiyaam*), and three Qunoot in the second Rakaat (In 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & 5<sup>th</sup> Qiyaam).

Details: Make intention as follows: (After Iqaamah-[optional]). I recite *Salaatul Ayaat Wajib Qurbatan Ilal-Laah* 

Takbiratul Ihraam.

### **First Rakaat**

- 1. Surah Al-Fatihah and another short Surah (Ikhlaas, etc.)
- 2. Go in Ruku (First Ruku), then stand erect fore second Qiyaam
- 3. Repeat the same procedure (*Qiyaam* & Ruku), until Five Qiyaam and five Ruku completed.
- 4. After standing up from last Ruku and go in Sajdah x2 (like usual Salaat)

## Second Rakaat

- 5. Repeat the above steps (3, 4, 5 & 6)
- 6. Complete the Salaat with *Tashahhud* and *Salaam*.

Other considerations:

- 1. Since it is an obligatory prayer, it should be offered as *Qaza* afterwards if missed, if it was not offered during the event.
- 2. It may be offered in Congregation. The rules are same as any obligatory congregational prayer.
